- 7,300,000 Euros of total investment
- 245 Accessible Tourist offices and structures
- 112 Accessible sites of historical interest (museums, monuments, churches etc.)
- 11 Foundations
- 88 Organisations involved
- 92 Accessible urban public spaces (gardens, parks, squares, markets, etc.)
- 66 Accessible public buildings (libraries, schools, theatres, banks, post offices etc.)
- 50 Experts in accessibility and planning
- 46 NGOs and associations
- 44 Innovative technological tools and services improving the access to information implemented (smart cane, audio guides, cyber passes)


